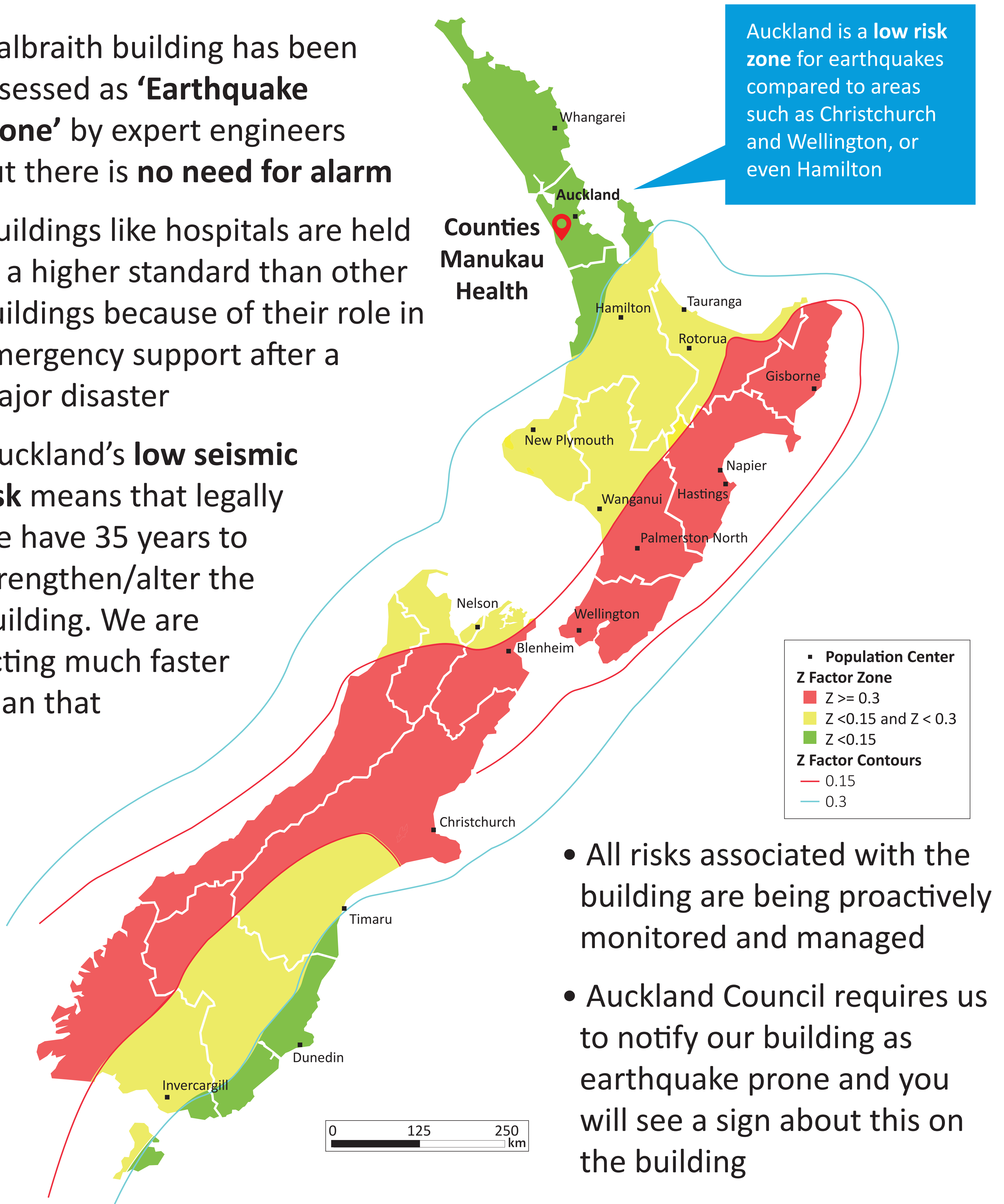


# Earthquake Assessment

- Galbraith building has been assessed as **'Earthquake Prone'** by expert engineers but there is **no need for alarm**
- Buildings like hospitals are held to a higher standard than other buildings because of their role in emergency support after a major disaster
- Auckland's **low seismic risk** means that legally we have 35 years to strengthen/alter the building. We are acting much faster than that



- All risks associated with the building are being proactively monitored and managed
- Auckland Council requires us to notify our building as earthquake prone and you will see a sign about this on the building
